There are 2,700 Carers in Wiltshire who are under the age of 18.

Who is a Carer?

A Carer is someone who looks after a relative, partner or a friend who cannot manage at home without help due to a disability or illness or because they are elderly or frail.

You are not alone

There are an estimated 700,000 young carers in the UK, some as young as 5 years old.

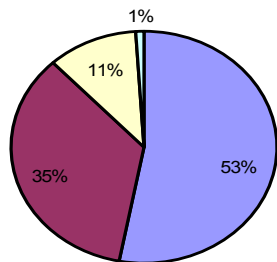
In Wiltshire:

53% of Registered Young Carers care for their Mum

35% Care for their sibling

11% Care for their Dad

1% Care for their Grandparents



Young Carers

Under 25 year olds

A young carer is a child or young person (aged from 5 to 25) whose life is affected by caring for at least one family member, over and above just 'helping out'. This could include caring for:

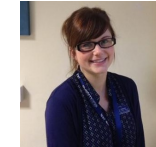
- Parent (s)
- Grandparents (s)
- Sibling (s)
- Close relatives (s)

What do Young Carers do?

- Household chores: washing, cleaning
- Preparing and Cooking food
- Personal care: helping to dress, feed or wash
- Giving medication
- Communicating on behalf of other: signing
- Ensuring someone's safety
- Providing emotional support
