# Booking a No Worries appointment

Simply ask for a no worries appointment at reception and they can book you into an appointment to see a practice nurse, on the day within surgery hours.

#### I'm worried or embarrassed to ask

If this sounds like you, then there is no need to worry as we won't ask you to say out loud why you need the appointment. At reception there will be a question card for you to take and fill in, simply give it back to reception and they will give you an appointment best suited to you.

"I am not a patient at your practice, can I still book a no worries appointment?"

"Yes! Young people are still able to book a no worries appointment even if you are not registered with us!"

# **No Worries**



No worries is a free service to advise those who are aged 24 and under about sexual health issues, relationships or any other health issues which may cause them some concern. This service also deals with young people who have un-answered questions and queries about sexual health.

# Includes:

- Free emergency contraception
- Contraception advice
- Free condoms
- Pregnancy testing
- Chlamydia testing
- Drug + Alcohol advice
- Any other sexual, health or relationship advice

#### Confidentiality!

The no worries service, is available to under 16 year olds right through to 24 year olds, it is a confidential and free sexual health service. We would only share your information with other professionals to protect you or others from serious harm. We would always try to discuss this with you first.

If you have any questions about confidentiality, please feel free to speak to the Nurse or your Doctor.

Patients of any age are able to make an appointment to see a doctor or nurse. We provide a confidential service to all young people including under 16's. This means you can tell others about your visit, but we won't.

# Contraception



### Be proud to carry a condom!

Condoms are the only contraception to protect against both pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Condoms are the number one protection to prevent pregnancy, if used correctly they are 98% effective.

There are different types of condoms to use, but it is important to check the wrapper for the BSI or CE kite mark which stands out to be good quality and safe to use. It is also important to check the date displayed on the condom wrapper.



Here are the kite marks to look out for.

#### Free condoms!

As apart of the no worries service at the surgery we provide free condom packs to anyone who is aged 24 and under. In the packs you will find: 10x variety of condoms, 1x lube, 1x no worries info card, 1x best to test card, 1x best to test leaflet, 1x condom info sheet. Simply pick up a pack at reception or book

a no worries appointment.

#### Best to test....

If you are worried that you've had unprotected sex. free test me kits are available to pick up from front reception.

Free test me kits are a simple kit to test against Chlamydia. You can also order them online at www.freetest.me

# **Emergency Contraception**



#### The sooner the better...

If you have had unprotected sex, or may think the contraception did not work, you can use emergency contraception which can still prevent pregnancy.

There are two methods of emergency contraception:

1) Emergency hormonal contraception (The morning after pill) - The pills come in a packet of two and must be taken together. the sooner you take it the more effective they are.

Taken within 24hours— Prevents 9 out of 10 pregnancies expected to occur without the emergency contraception.

Taken within 72hours—Prevents 5 out 10 pregnancies expected to occur without the emergency contraception.

2) The Copper IUD- Intrauterine device This emergency contraception will need to be fitted within a clinic by a doctor or nurse. it can be fitted up to five days after having sexual intercourse. IUD prevents 9 out of 10 pregnancies expected to occur without the emergency contraception.
